Late and short-lived companion to [Curtis's Botanical Magazine](#) and [Edwards's Botanical Register](#). 10 volumes were planned, but only 3 were published, probably from 1850 to 1853<sup>1)</sup>. Each volume was composed of 12 fascicles of 3 color plates and “gleanings and memoranda”. 2 cactus and 7 other succulents are presented in the following file.
