

The second part is devoted to the 28 families (suffix - aceae) of succulent plants. The end of the book presents a glossary, a general bibliography and an index. Although the "rules of the nomenclature game" have changed slightly since 1980, the book is still very useful and the clarity with Gordon Rowley's typical English humor makes it a must.




